Job Purpose:

The Project Manager will deliver key planned maintenance & major works projects on time, to the specified quality standard and in line with approved budgets, across a national geography. Working closely and proactively with colleagues across Asset Management and the wider business, the Project Manager will deliver high levels of customer satisfaction. Positive communication with stakeholders and proactive management of contractors, either directly or via external specialist consultants, will be key to the success of this role.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Effectively contract manage and deliver planned maintenance component renewal and major works projects.
- Utilise professional knowledge and expertise to take full management control of projects to deliver target business objectives in relation to the planned investment programme.
- Attend sites as required across a national geography to maintain standards and progress, in combination with utilising, where it is appropriate and more efficient to maintain a local presence, our network of local in-house asset managers and external specialist consultants.
- Ensure safe working is embedded across all projects, maintaining compliance with Construction, Design and Management (CDM) regulations.
- Manage the performance of contractors against KPI's and contract requirements, chairing regular contract meetings to ensure progress is maintained and quality is delivered.
- Investigate and respond to customer complaints, providing evidence of lessons learnt to drive improvements in service delivery.
- Effective management of project budgets, ensuring contract costs are controlled and any variations approved in line with Salvation Army Homes standing orders and financial probity requirements.
- Provide regular reports to senior management demonstrating progress against the planned programme and, liaising closely with finance colleagues, demonstrating accurate expenditure against budget.
- Ensure effective consultation with customers and develop excellent working relationships with colleagues across the business, attending meetings where required, to promote and communicate works programmes and projects under your control.
- Proactively represent Salvation Army Homes in any interaction with external agencies as necessary for the delivery of projects.
